MCSO SHUTS DOWN HIGH-END DRUG HOUSE, RESTORES PEACE TO PALM CITY NEIGHBORHOOD

Following numerous complaints about suspected drug activity taking place inside a home in an upscale Palm City community, the Martin County Sheriff's Office Special Investigations team put on their suburban drug-fighting attire and went to work — ultimately shutting down what turned out to be a very active drug house.

The home, located on the 5000 block of SW Bimini Circle in the Evergreen community, had also been the subject of multiple overdose investigations, including one overdose death, adding even greater concern to the operation.

Following an extensive investigation, MCSO Special Investigations detectives ultimately executed a search warrant on the home. Three individuals were arrested, including 45-year-old Jeremy T. Mulvey, 34-year-old Delaney Lewis, and 38-year-old Dontavius Adger. Mulvey, who was the homeowner, was charged with possession of drug paraphernalia and possession of a firearm and ammunition by a convicted felon. Adger was arrested on an outstanding warrant for possession with intent to sell. Lewis was found to be out on bond from a previous arrest. Cocaine and fentanyl was seized from house.

Thanks to the vigilance and tips submitted by concerned neighbors, detectives were able to garner enough information to investigate and shut down this suburban nightmare.
